2015 - 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness Update 10-25-2016

History and Purpose of the Plan

- Legislation in 2005 required counties to create localized plans to end homelessness
- Same legislation provided revenue to fund the plans via Document Recording Fees
- In 2015 housing providers and community partners drafted a plan that identified local priorities to direct efforts



2015 Planning Process



- Formation of Executive Committee
- Information gathering via data and interviews
 - Current draft of plan works to incorporate input from stakeholders
 - Bringing the plan back to the community for review and reflection (does it reflect our concerns and priorities?)
- Needs Assessment
- Workshops and Site Visits
- Identify Strategies to Address Homelessness
- Draft a work plan to guide efforts

Contributing Factors to Homelessness

High and Long-term Unemployment and Poverty

- Lack of employment opportunities
- End of unemployment benefits for many
- 46% of Grays Harbor residents accessed DSHS services in 2014


Barriers to Housing

- Poor Credit History
- Criminal History
- Rural geography
- Mental health, substance abuse, and physical disabilities

Lack of Safe, Affordable Housing

- 30% of all County Households are severely cost-burdened, paying 50% or more of their household income towards housing
- For every 100 Households who earn 0-30% of AMI (\$0 \$15,630)
 there are only 17 units of safe, affordable housing available

Identified Strategies



- Fully Develop Coordinated Entry
 - Maintain and Expand Affordable Housing options
 - 3. Invest in Housing Resources for vulnerable populations
 - Build and Strengthen Housing System
 - 5. Increase Community awareness and education

- UGM is fundraising to expand services
- CCS is providing leadership and expertise to local efforts
