GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY JAIL OPIATE INTERVENTION PROGRAM

Grays Harbor County Jail



Reduces recidivism caused by opiate use disorder. The program also prevents opioid overdose deaths by providing inmates information and referral to treatment resources in the community. In some cases, medication assisted treatment is available for persons in custody.

For some persons more seriously impacted by opiate use disorder, inpatient services are recommended. Often preceded by services at a detoxification center.

SYRINGE SERVICES PROGRAM

A harm-reduction strategy to prevent disease transmission, provide information and referral to persons with opioid use disorder. Naloxone distribution.
