## Performance Benchmarks

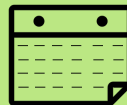
Our mission is to make homelessness rare, brief, and one-time

- Housing supports for Therapeutic Court clients - Supportive Housing Services - Supportive Employment Services - Pathways Care Coordination - Coordinated Entry - Shelter for Domestic Violence Survivors - Supportive Housing for Domestic Violence Survivors - Emergency Shelter for Families -

## We created new resources...

- Increase the number of Supportive Housing units for Domestic Violence Victims from 3 to 8
- Developed & Launched Grays Harbor Affordable Housing Pipeline
- Applied for 25 Family Reunification Vouchers
- Applied for 15 811 Vouchers
- Completed initial systems analysis using Department of Commerce racial equity tool
- Implemented 25 units of Cold Weather Shelter
- Added Youth Outreach Coordinator & Youth Housing Navigator positions at CCAP
- Began renovations and licensing for a 6 bed emergency shelter to homeless youth (12-17)
- Implemented 16 units of Permanent Supportive Housing through the HUD McKinney Vento PSH program

## And laid the foundation for future projects.

- Implement a robust, year round, multifaceted emergency shelter
- Implement 1 FTE Diversion Specialist
- Implement transitional hours for those exiting systems of care
- Review/refine performance/outcome data
- Review/revise plan
- Develop 20 units with monthly housing costs between \$390-\$650
- Develop 20 units with monthly housing costs between \$650-\$1,042
- Develop 20 units with monthly housing costs between \$1,042-\$1,556
- Expand accessibility to CE
