A Resolution of the Grays Harbor County Board of Health  
Discontinuing the Syringe Exchange Program Operated by the  
Grays Harbor County Public Health and Social Services Department

WHEREAS, the Grays Harbor County Board of Health ("Board of Health") approved Resolution # BOH-04-01 on January 15, 2004, authorizing the establishment and implementation of a syringe exchange program in Grays Harbor County, to be run by the Grays Harbor County Public Health and Social Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the syringe exchange program is currently funded through Treatment Sales Tax, grants and donations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health believes that the operation of a syringe exchange in Grays Harbor County is not an appropriate use of taxpayer money,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY that Grays Harbor County will discontinue funding the operation and service of the Syringe Exchange Program on April 1, 2021.
